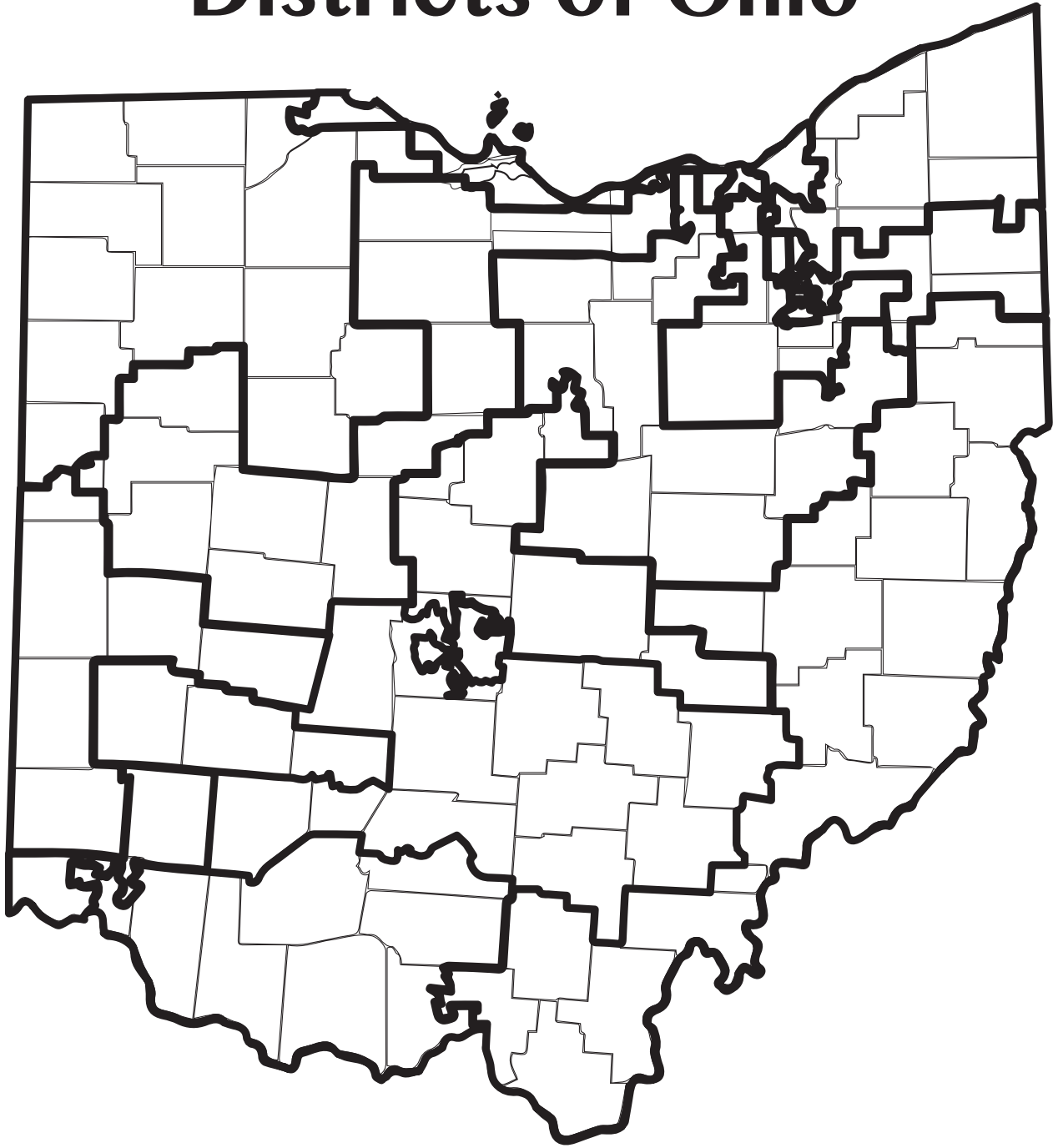


Current Congressional Districts of Ohio



Each thickly outlined section on this map is a **district**, which means that they are all represented by a different person in the U.S. Congress. Does the way the districts are drawn seem silly? We think so too! This is called **gerrymandering**. Politicians do it so they can get elected more easily.

Do you think you could do a better job of drawing the districts? You probably could! Flip this page over and show us. Use the thinly outlined **counties** as guidelines, and keep in mind that there need to be **16 districts total** because of the number of people in Ohio. Then, show this map to your parents, and tell them to visit www.fairdistrictsohio.org to learn more about **redistricting** and **Issue 1**, which will be on the ballot **May 8!**

Issue 1 is a **proposed amendment** to the constitution of Ohio to create a bipartisan process that strongly encourages **both major parties to agree** on a congressional map that better represents the views of Ohioans.

Issue 1 includes **greater transparency** and strong rules that focus on **keeping communities together** and prohibitions on gerrymandering if the two political parties come to an impasse.
